A CPESC is a recognized specialist in soil erosion and sediment control. This designation is given to specialists who have met established standards of expertise, experience and knowledge. The certification program was created over 25 years ago to provide professional credentials to individuals working on construction-site erosion and sediment control issues. This program now has active registrants in over 15 countries around the world. CPESC certification is required by numerous local governments, state governments, provinces and is recognized in several state Construction General Permits.

2. Four reference letters from erosion and sediment control professionals familiar with your work.
